## Technology

For a device to be checked out to students, the following steps should be completed:

1. Optional: Pay the annual maintenance fee online or in person on campus.
2. Sign and review the Secondary Device Usage Agreement online by signing into your account. If you are unable to submit the agreement online, you may print a copy of the form and submit it to your campus.



## Advisory
